Location

The Immunocore offices are located on Milton Park, just off the A34 close to the M4 and M40 and with fast rail links from nearby Didcot Parkway station to London, Bristol, Oxford and Reading. Heathrow Airport is just one hour drive away.

Directions to Immunocore main office (building 101)

Enter Milton Park from the A34 and pass the Park Security Building on your left. At the roundabout the Park Centre is on your right (a large 'tent like' building) – take the second exit to carry straight on. At the next roundabout take the second exit to carry on along the main road, and then take the second turning on the right. Follow the signs to 101 Park Drive (see Milton Park map on page 3). Immunocore is located on the first floor.

Directions to Immunocore main office (building 127 North – unit 13/14)

Enter Milton Park from the A34 and pass the Park Security Building on your left. At the roundabout the Park Centre is on your right (a large 'tent like' building) – take the second exit to carry straight on. At the next roundabout take the second exit to carry on along the main road, and then take the third turning on the left onto 'Olympic Avenue'. Once on 'Olympic Avenue', take the first right which leads you into a car park. As you turn into the car park Building 127 North will be on your left. Immunocore are located within unit 13 and 14 of 127 North.

Directions to Immunocore office (building 90)

Enter Milton Park from the A34 and pass the Park Security Building on your left. At the roundabout the Park Centre is on your right (a large 'tent like' building) – take the second exit to carry straight on. At the next roundabout take the second exit to carry on along the main road, and then take the first turning on the left. Follow the signs to 90 Park Drive (see Milton Park map on page 3). Visitor's car park is in front of the building.

Directions to Immunocore office (building 93)

Enter Milton Park from the A34 and pass the Park Security Building on your left. At the roundabout take the second exit to carry straight on. Pass through the pedestrian crossing traffic lights and then take the next left, signposted Jubilee Avenue. Continue down Jubilee Avenue until you reach a mini roundabout. Turn right at the roundabout, Immunocore is located on your right hand side – 93 Innovation Drive (see Milton Park map on page 3). Visitor's car park is on the right hand side of the main entrance.

Directions to Immunocore offices (buildings 57 and 59)

Enter Milton Park from the A34 and pass the Park Security Building on your left. At the roundabout the Park Centre is on your right (a large 'tent like' building) – take the second exit to carry straight on. Pass through the pedestrian crossing traffic lights and then take the next left, signposted Jubilee Avenue. Immunocore is the second low-level white building on your left. Take the first turning on the left, between the low white buildings, and at the cross roads turn left and immediately left again. Parking is on the left in front of the building and Reception entrance is located at the end of the building (see Milton Park map on page 3).

By Road

Milton Park is located close to the A34 road just 12 miles south of Oxford. There is direct access to the M4 (13 miles south) and to the M40 (23 miles north). Milton Park is signposted directly from the Milton Interchange turn off on the A34.

By Rail

Didcot Parkway station is only 3 miles to the east of Milton Park and is a 5 minute taxi ride to the Immunocore offices. Didcot Parkway station provides frequent and fast rail connections to London and the West.

By Air

The closest international airport is London Heathrow (LHR), from which a frequent Heathrow Express train link can take you directly into London Paddington train station (approx. 15 minutes journey time). From Paddington station, pick up a train to Didcot Parkway station (approx. 1 hour journey). Immunocore offices are a short 5 minute taxi ride from Didcot Parkway train station. Alternatively, if travelling by road from Heathrow airport to Immunocore offices, it is recommended to allow 1 hour 30 minutes in case of heavy traffic.
